

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

**BY-LAW NO. 1999-85**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE THE LANEWAY  
BETWEEN CLIFFORD AVENUE AND HOWARD AVENUE  
IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that the laneway between Howard Avenue and Clifford Avenue in the City of North Bay be closed to vehicular traffic;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, by the Council of the said City, or a Committee of said Council;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That certain laneway between Howard Avenue and Clifford Avenue in the City of North Bay shown on Registered Plan No. 36M-202 abutting Lots 155 to 157, designated as Part 1, Plan 36R-10684 is hereby closed to vehicular traffic by way of a one-foot reserve at the limit of Clifford Avenue.
2. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of this by-law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 28<sup>TH</sup> DAY JUNE, 1999.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF AUGUST, 1999.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 9<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF AUGUST, 1999.
