## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 175-92

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A PORTION OF MEMORIAL DRIVE FROM QUEEN STREET TO A POINT 0.2 KM. EAST OF THE GOVERNMENT DOCK.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Nipissing Provincial Progressive Conservative Association, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Memorial Drive pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Sec. 208, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the portion of Memorial Drive from Queen Street to a point 0.2 km. east of Government Dock in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 8:30 o'clock in the afternoon until 10:30 o'clock in the afternoon, on Sunday the 6th day of September 1992 or on Monday the 7th day of September 1992 during the aforementioned times if requested by the applicant, for the purpose of a fireworks display.
- 2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closures.
- 3. That prior to 11:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 6th day of September 1992, or the 7th day of September 1992, the Nipissing Provincial Progressive Conservative Association will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Memorial Drive, to its condition prior to the above closure.
