

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 36-84

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 40-70
BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A LOTTERY LICENCING
OFFICER AND TO PROVIDE FOR A PROCEDURE AND
OTHER REQUIREMENTS IN RESPECT OF THE
LICENCING OF LOTTERIES FOR CHARITABLE AND
RELIGIOUS PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay
deems it advisable to limit the aggregate of all prizes offered
or given at any one bingo to \$2,500.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 40-70 be amended by deleting Section 5
thereto and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 5. The Corporation shall issue licences to applicants
for permission to manage and conduct lotteries
pursuant to this by-law, in accordance with the
following schedule of fees:
 1. Bingo Lotteries:
 - (a) That the aggregate amount of all prizes
offered or given at any one bingo event
shall not exceed \$2,500.
 - (b) Where the total value of prizes to be awarded
within each operation does not exceed
\$500.00 - \$5.00 per licence; provided that
where such total value does not exceed \$25.00,
a fee of \$2.00 shall be charged.
 - (c) Where the total value of prizes to be awarded
within each operation exceeds \$500.00 but is
not more than \$2,500.00 - a fee of 2% of the
total value of prizes as set out in the
application.
 - (d) A licence for a series of bingo lotteries shall
be issued on the same basis as (a) or (b)
above.
2. That this By-law shall come into force and effect
1 May 1984.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9TH DAY OF APRIL, 1984.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 24th DAY OF APRIL, 1984.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 24th
