THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 123-85

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 52-85 BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE MAIN STREET FROM FRASER STREET TO FERGUSON STREET AND BETWEEN FERGUSON STREET AND WYLD STREET.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close portions of Main Street pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302, s. 208, subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That Clause 1 of By-law No. 52-85 be amended by deleting all the words after the word "traffic" in the fourth line and replaced with the following: "from 7:00 o'clock in the forenoon to 5:30 p.m. in the afternoon on 7, 14, 21 and 28 September 1985 for the purpose of a Saturday Farmers' Market" so that Clause 1 shall now read as follows: "Subject to section 2 hereof, that portion of Main Street from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street and from Ferguson Street to Wyld Street in the City of North Bay shall be closed to vehicular traffic from 7:00 o'clock in the forenoon to 5:30 p.m. in the afternoon on 7, 14, 21 and 28 September 1985 for the purpose of a Saturday Farmers' Market."
