BY-LAW NO. 2241

BEING A BY-LAW to fix the Polling places and appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the holding of Municipal Elections in the year 1965 for the Municipality of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-Law fixing Polling Places and to appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors, to select a Mayor and ten (10) Aldermen to transact the Municipal affairs of the City and for the selection of eight (8) Public School Trustees, and eight (8) Separate School Trustees, and two (2) Hydro Commissioners, all to be elected by General Vote.

WHEREAS in any local municipality where difficulty arises in obtaining a suitable Polling Place in any Polling Subdivision, By-laws may be passed by authority of Section 61 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, or as amended to provide a place for such Polling Subdivision in an adjoining Polling subdivision.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

24. THAT the City Clerk shall attend the ¹⁶⁸⁰ Council Chambers at the hour of twelve o'clock noon on the 15th day of December, A.D. 1965 for the final summing up of the number of votes for the Mayor and Aldermen, Public and Separate School Trustees and Hydro Commissioners.
