

By-Law 626

BEING a By-Law to provide for the leasing and erecting and keeping of a Gasoline Tank on the highways of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to pass a By-law for regulating, keeping and leasing the space required for the erection of the Gasoline Tanks and pipes connected thereto on the highways, streets or portion of the streets of the Town of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That no person shall be permitted to erect or keep any Gasoline Tank or pipes connected therewith on the streets of the Town of North Bay without first obtaining permission from the Town Council and paying a fee of \$15.00 for the use of the space occupied by said Tank and pipes connected therewith.
2. That the said fee shall be paid annually on the 1st day of January in each year, provided always that, where above permission is granted during the year the License Fee for the unexpired portion of the Calendar year shall be at the rate of \$1.25 per month or portion thereof.
3. That any person securing the right or permission to construct said tank or pipes shall hold such right only at the will and pleasure of the Municipality and shall move same off the highways or streets of the Municipality on receiving one weeks notice and shall be entitled to a refund for any portion of the year for which said tank and pipes have not been used, but shall have no other claim against the said Municipality.
4. That any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting magistrate, a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$10.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs; and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith, the said penalty and costs, or costs only, may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender; and in case of there being no distress found out of which such penalty can be levied, the

convicting magistrate may commit the offender to the Common Gaol of the Town of North with or without hard labor, for any period not exceeding six calendar months, unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.

5. THIS BY-LAW shall come into effect immediately on the passing thereof.
