

BY-LAW NO. 2310

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law 1896,
a By-law to regulate traffic within
the limits of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend said By-law 1896

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH
BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Clause (1) of Section Sixteen be amended by
adding thereto as subsection (a) the following:

(a) A vehicle of the North Bay Police Department
in that area set out on the north side of
McIntyre Street, being distant 100 lineal
feet westerly from the west limits of Ferguson
Street and extending 67 lineal feet westerly.

2. THAT "SCHEDULE "C" (THROUGH STREETS) be amended to
read:

Ferguson Street	At every intersecting street between Main Street and Chippewa Street
Oak Street	At every intersecting street between Ninth Street and Golf Street

3. THAT SCHEDULE "H" (PARKING RESTRICTED LIMITED TIME)
be amended to read:

Fraser Street	Both First Ave. to Second Ave.	1 hr. 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.	Monday to Sat. incl.

4. THAT SCHEDULE "J" PART "C" (PARKING METER ZONE)
be amended by adding thereto:

Fraser St.	Both	Worthington St. to First Ave.	Two hour

of final approval by The Ontario Department of Transport.
