

BY-LAW NO. 1982

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize expenditures for the resurfacing of Main Street from Bell Street to Algonquin Avenue, and the construction of a reinforced concrete retaining wall on Fisher Street from a point opposite Fifth Avenue a distance of 158' easterly towards Princess Street.

WHEREAS by authority of By-law No. 198¹³, the Corporation of the City of North Bay did enter into a "Connecting Link Agreement" with the Minister of Highways, and

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a by-law authorizing expenditure of Municipal funds under the term of said Agreement.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT expenditures of Eight Thousand, Seven Hundred and fifth dollars (\$8,750.00) and One Thousand Seven Hundred and fifth dollars (\$1,750.00) respectively, being the Municipality's share of the cost of resurfacing of Main Street from Bell Street to Algonquin Avenue and the construction of a reinforced concrete retaining wall on Fisher Street from a point opposite Fifth Avenue a distance of 158' easterly towards Princess Street, under the terms of the said Connecting Link Agreement, be hereby authorized as provided for in the current budget.
2. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute the necessary documents in connection herewith and to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
