

BY-LAW NO. 475

BEING A BY-LAW for the assumption by the Town of North Bay of a portion of the cost of construction of Sidewalks within the limits of the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is provided by the Local Improvement Act that the Municipal Corporation may assume part of the cost of construction of granolithic, stone cement, asphalt, or brick sidewalks, which shall be paid by the Corporation on certain terms and conditions.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay to pass such a By-Law by the said Municipality..

BEN IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:-

1. From and after the passing of this By-Law, one half of the cost of every granolithic, stone cement, asphalt or brick sidewalk, or of every pavement or curbing constructed as a Local Improvement, which otherwise would be chargeable upon the land abutting directly on the work, shall hereafter be paid by the Corporation and in addition thereto, the entire cost of construction of all crossings constructed within the Town shall hereafter be borne by the Municipality.
2. The Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay consists of ten members and 9 members of the said Council voted in favor of the passing of this By-Law
3. This By-Law shall take effect immediately after the passing thereof.
4. This By-Law was passed at a general meeting of the said Council held this 5th day of June, A. D. 1916.
