✓ By-Law 680

BEING a By-law to change the names of certain streets, and parts of streets in the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS under the Provisions of Consolidated Municipal Act, 12-13 George V. 1922, Chapter 72, Section 400, Sub-section 38, Municipal Councils of Urban Municipalities are authorized to pass a By-law with the approval of the Judge of the District Court, and by a vote of three-fourths of all the members of the Council, changing the name of the high-way within the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the said changes be made for the following reasons:-

- (1) To avoid confusion on account of some of the streets being named the same.
- (2) It would be more convenient that the change should be made.
- (3) Some of the streets are a continuation of other streets.

BE IT ENACTED, AND IT IS THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY, AS FOLLOWS:-

- (1) That the following streets be changed and new names substituted therefore, namely:-

IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF NIPISSING.

IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION BY THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY, TO HAVE THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY CHANGED AND NEW NAMES SUBSTITUTED THEREFOR.

I, WILLIAM H. SNYDER, of the Town of North Bay in the District of Nipissing, Town Clerk, make oath and say:

1. THAT I am the Clerk of the Town of North Bay, and have full knowledge of the matters herein deposed to.
2. THAT an application was made by the Corporation of the Town of North Bay for changing the names of certain streets and parts of streets within the Town of North Bay.
3. THAT an advertisement giving description of the changes to be made and the time the application was to be heard, was inserted in a news paper published in the Town of North Bay, namely "The Nugget" on the Twenty-sixth day of June, 1923; the Third day of July, 1923; the Tenth day of July, 1923 and the Seventeenth day of July, 1923 respectively.
4. THAT I believe that it is in the public interest that the said changes should be made and no opposition has been ~~passed~~ ^{passed} before the Council opposing said changes.
5. THAT I am informed and verily believe that all the necessary proceedings have been taken as required by the Municipal Act for carrying out the said changes.
6. THAT a copy of the said changes was published in the Ontario Gazette on the Thirtieth day of June, 1923.

7. THAT now shown to me and marked Exhibit "A" to this my affidavit is a copy of the Judge's notice required to be published in connection with the By-law to be passed for the changing of the names of the said streets.
