

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 89-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE
OF VOTING RECORDERS AND A VOTING RECORDER
SYSTEM AT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE
CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS Section 42 of The Municipal Elections
Act, 1977 provides that a Council of a municipality may, by
by-law passed on or before the 1st day of April in an election
year, authorize the use of voting recorders or other
voting devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of
the City of North Bay enacts as follows:


1. The use of voting recorders and the system of
using the voting recorders known as the "Votomatic
System" developed by Computer Election Systems of
Berkeley, California, is hereby authorized in
respect to the municipal elections to be held in
1982 and in subsequent election years.
2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send forthwith
a certified copy of this by-law to the Minister of
Municipal Affairs and Housing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 8TH DAY OF JUNE, 1981.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 15TH DAY OF JUNE 1981.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS
15TH DAY OF JUNE 1981.
