THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 122-88

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, AND CLOSE A PORTION OF PRESTON STREET BETWEEN LAKESHORE DRIVE AND WILLIAM STREET IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the street hereinafter described be closed and stopped up;

AND WHAEREAS notice of this By-Law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this By-Law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, by the Council of the said City or a Committee of said Council;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That part of Preston Street, in the City of North Bay between Lakeshore Drive and William Street is hereby closed and stopped up, subject to a 10 foot wide pedestrian walkway to be constructed by the developer to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
- This By-Law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed and upon a certified copy of this By-Law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE $19\mathrm{TH}$ DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1988.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 19TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER , 1988.
