

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAYBY-LAW NO. 2333

Being a By-law to amend By-law No. 1981 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay regulating the establishment of ramps and driveways.

WHEREAS there are many residential properties in the City of North Bay of insufficient width to provide a driveway;

AND WHEREAS many of the owners or occupants of such residential properties park their motor vehicles on the street, thereby interfering with snow-ploughing operations by the City;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable and necessary to amend By-law No. 1981 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay to permit such owners or occupants as aforesaid as the Council may decide to park their respective motor vehicles on the front yard or lawn of such residential properties and to permit the construction of the necessary driveway for the aforesaid purposes;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 1981 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay be amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

9(a) Notwithstanding anything contained in this By-law to the contrary, the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, upon the application of the owner of any residential property in the City of North Bay which is of insufficient width to provide a driveway and upon the recommendation of the City Engineer, may authorize the City Engineer to issue a permit to such owner for the construction of a driveway of such width as the City Engineer may recommend in order that such owner or occupant of such residential property as aforesaid may park his motor vehicle on the front yard or lawn of such residential property. The construction of such driveway shall be subject to the provisions of Paragraphs 6, 7, 8 and 9 of this By-law.
