BY-LAW NO. 2008-182

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND CONVEY
A PORTION OF THE UNOPENED ROAD ALLOWANCE
IN THE PERUT PLACE SUBDIVISION,
IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the unopened road allowance in the Perut Place Subdivision abutting Lots 1, 2, 3, 11 and 12, Plan M-539 be closed, stopped up and transferred to the original dedicating owner;

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2008-481 passed on the 23rd day of June 2008, Council approved the closure of the unopened road allowance;

AND WHEREAS the unopened road allowance abutting Lots 1, 2, 3, 11 and 12, Plan M-539 is hereby declared to be surplus;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That certain part of the unopened road allowance abutting Lots 1, 2, 3, 11 and 12, Plan M-539 designated as Parts 1 to14, both inclusive, on Reference Plan 36R-10620 is hereby closed, stopped up and conveyed.
2. The City shall transfer Parts 1 to14, both inclusive, on Reference Plan 36R-10620 to the original dedicating owner.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF JULY, 2008.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 18TH DAY OF AUGUST, 2008.
