BY-IAW NO. 1680

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1512 of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend By-law No. 1512, being a By-law to provide for the licensing and regulating of dogs in the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT paragraph 2 of By-law No. 1512 be repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- 2. THAT the owner of any dog shall not permit such dog to run at large at any time during the course of the year in any of the public parks, squares, drives, streets, lanes, or other public place in the City of North Bay, or upon any premises not owned or leased by the owner, unless such dog is accompanied, by, and is under the immediate charge and control of some competent person, and such dog is at all times on a leash, and any dog found running at large, contrary to this provision, will be liable to be captured and disposed of as hereinafter provided. "
