

BY-LAW NO. 2099

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend By-law No. 1967, a by-law requiring the closing of Barber Shops during certain hours and regulating the operation of Barber Shops.

WHEREAS by petition of the qualified Barbers of the City of North Bay in numbers equal to 88.5% of all Barber Shop Operators, it is petitioned that By-law No. 1967 be amended to provide clarification of the trade of barbering.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


- 1. That Clause 4 of By-law No. 1967 be amended by adding thereto Clause 4 (a) which reads as follows:-

Clause 4(a). Barber Shops shall mean any establishment catering PRIMARILY TO MEN, offering services in the nature of cutting of hair, styling of hair, special treatment of hair or scalp, tinting, dyeing, shampooing or any other service related or incidental to any or all of the above.
