

BY-LAW NO. 974

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for the regulation and licensing of various places of amusements and particularly those places known as Miniature Golf Courses within the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that a By-Law should be passed for the regulation and the licensing of such places of amusement known as Miniature Golf Courses within the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay. Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay under and by virtue of the authority vested in the said Municipal Corporation by the Municipal Act. R. S. O. 1927, Chapter 233, Section 429, Sub-Section 2, enacts as follows:--

- 1. THAT any person or persons constructing or operating Miniature Golf Courses or similar places of amusement shall, prior to the construction and operation of such Golf Courses or places of amusement within the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay pay to the Treasurer of the said Municipality the annual license fee of \$50.00.
- 2. THE annual license shall expire on the 31st day of December of the year in which the said license was issued.
- 3. THAT no Miniature Golf Course shall be operated on a Sunday or between the hours of 11.30 P. M. and 7.00 A. M. on Week days.
- 4. THAT anyone constructing, operating or maintaining a Miniature Golf Course or similar place of amusement within the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay contrary to the provisions of this By-Law shall incur a penalty of not less than \$10.00 and not exceeding \$25.00.
- 5. THE provisions of this By-Law shall be enforced under the provisions of the Summary Convictions Act of the Province of Ontario.
- 6. THAT this By-Law take effect on the 1st day of January 1931.
