

BY-LAW NO. 1829

BEING A BY LAW to fix the Polling Places and appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the holding of Municipal Elections for the year 1957 in the Municipality of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-Law fixing Polling Places and appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors, to select a Mayor and Ten (10) Aldermen (to be elected by General Vote) to transact the Municipal affairs of the City and for the selection of Three Public School Trustees and One Hydro Commissioner to be elected by General Vote:

WHEREAS in any local municipality where difficulty arises in obtaining a suitable Polling Place in any Polling Subdivision By-laws may be passed by authority of Section 84 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1950 as amended, to provide a place for such Polling subdivision in an adjoining Polling Subdivision.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Corbeil, Poll Clerk, for Polling Place No. 1-B.

THAT the Railway Employees', Express Messengers' Truck Drivers', Bus Drivers', and Commercial Travellers' also voters who will be absent in the ordinary course of their business or employment as referred to in City of North Bay By-Law No. 1662 passed under the authority of Chapter 63, Sec. 111(a), Statutes on Ontario 1952, Advance Polling Place for the purpose of the said election shall be in the City Hall, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets, and Mr. Mel. Craigie is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer, and Mr. D. Cushing, Poll Clerk.
24. THAT the City Clerk shall attend the Council Chambers at the hour of twelve o'clock noon on the 11th day of December, A. D., 1957 for the final summing up of the number of votes for the Mayor and Aldermen, School Trustees and Hydro Commissioner.
