BY-LAW NO. 44-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH ONTARIO NORTHLAND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION. (CHIEF COMMANDA 1)

WHEREAS the council deems it desirable to provide a waterfront location for the heritage display and commercial use of the Chief Commanda 1 at a nominal rent, with all costs related thereto borne by the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission pursuant to section 191 and 193 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, chap. M.45.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to enter into that certain agreement dated March 1, 1993 between The Corporation of the City of North Bay and Ontario Northland Transportation Commission relating to the use of land at the waterfront for the purpose of using the Chief Commanda 1 as a restaurant, museum and gift shop.
- That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement dated March 1, 1993 between The Corporation of the City of North Bay and Ontario Northland Transportation Commission and to affix thereto the corporate seal.
