

BY-LAW NUMBER 870.

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law number 612 respecting the licensing of Pawnbrokers.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deems it necessary, to conform with the Revised Statutes, to amend By-law number 612 respecting the licensing of Pawnbrokers.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS: /

1. THAT Clause No. 4 of the said By-Law number 612 be and the same is hereby repealed.

2. THAT a new clause No. 4 be inserted as follows:

Clause No. 4: The sum of \$60. shall be paid for every license or renewal thereof to the Treasurer, for the use of the municipality, and every Pawnbroker shall give to the municipality security to the satisfaction of the Treasurer thereof in the sum of \$1,000. for the due observance by him of the provisions of this Act.

Read a first time in Open Council this 30th day of January, 1928.

Read a second time in Open Council this 30th day of January, 1928.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-law was read a third time short and passed this 30th day of January, 1928.
