

BY-LAW NO. 981

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. Eight Hundred and Nineteen (819) being a By-Law amending By-Law No. Seven Hundred and Ninety-two (792) of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend By-Law No. Eight Hundred and Nineteen (819) being a By-Law providing for the licensing and regulation of dogs.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

That paragraph Five (5) of By-Law Number Seven Hundred and Ninety-two (792) as amended by By-Law Number Eight Hundred and Nineteen (819) be and the same is hereby repealed and the following paragraph Five (5) be substituted therefor.

"No person shall allow his dog to run at large in any of the Public Parks, Squares, Drives, Streets, Lanes, Alleys or other public places in the City of North Bay, unless such dog is accompanied by and is under the immediate charge and control of some competent person, and any dog found running at large contrary to this provision shall be liable to be captured and disposed of as hereinbefore provided.

This By-Law shall take effect immediately on the passing thereof.

Read a First and second time in Open Council this 20th day of October, A. D. 1930.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 20th day of October, A. D. 1930.
