

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2002-106

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF
LANDS FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
LAKESHORE UNITED MISSIONARY CHURCH
(656 – 662 Lakeshore Drive)

WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2002-417 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting on Monday, July 8, 2002 Council authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an Agreement to purchase 5.294 acres, being part of the properties located at 656 – 662 Lakeshore Drive, at a cost of \$71,000.00;

WHEREAS The Board of Trustees of the Lakeshore United Missionary Church own Parcels 6426 and 2423 Widdifield & Ferris, including Part Lots 39 & 40, Concession 15, in the former Township of West Ferris, now in the City of North Bay, District of Nipissing.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to purchase Part of Parcels 6426 and 2423 Widdifield & Ferris from The Board of Trustees of the Lakeshore United Missionary Church, and to pay the sum of \$71,000.00 therefore in such a manner as The Board of Trustees of the Lakeshore United Missionary Church may direct.
2. The Mayor, City Clerk and City Solicitor are hereby authorized to execute such documents as may be reasonably required to give effect to this purchase of land.
3. This By-Law comes into effect upon being passed.
