

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 69-94

A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE WASTE MANAGEMENT  
BY-LAW 135-92

WHEREAS the council intends to open a new landfill site as of June 27, 1994 in the Township of Merrick in accordance with its 3 R's Maximization Plan as required by the Environmental Assessment Act approval;

AND WHEREAS the council intends by this by-law to reduce recycling collections from once every to once every two weeks and to reduce regular collection from 6 bags to 4 bags and to enable residents from adjacent Townships to use the Merrick landfill if appropriate agreements are obtained.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subsection (1) of Section 3 of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by adding the following words to the end thereof: "once every second week according to a schedule fixed by the Director of Engineering and Environmental Services."
2. Subsection (1) (a) of Section 4 of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by deleting "34 kilograms" and inserting "15 kilograms" in lieu thereof.
3. Subsection (1) (b) of Section 4 of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by deleting "34 kilograms" and inserting "15 kilograms" in lieu thereof.
4. Subsection (2) of Section 4 of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by deleting subsection (a) in its entirety and inserting the following subsection 4 (2) (a) in lieu thereof:

"The total number of containers placed at curbside for the collection of solid waste shall not exceed four (4) per week from each self-contained dwelling unit."
5. Subsection (2) (f) of section 4 of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by deleting "more than 50" therefrom and inserting "50 to 75" in lieu thereof.
6. Subsection (2) of Section 4 of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph (j):

"(j) Collection from a multi-residential building having more than 75 dwelling units shall consist of one lift per week of one 6 cubic yard container placed and maintained on the site in a location and a manner and on terms satisfactory to the Director of Engineering and Environmental Services.
7. Section 6 of By-law 135-92 is amended by deleting paragraph (1) and inserting the following paragraph in lieu thereof:

"6. (1) No person shall deposit any material in any landfill site owned by The Corporation of the City of North Bay except according to the terms of this by-law."
8. Section 8 of By-law 135-92 is amended by deleting paragraphs (1) and (2) and inserting the following paragraphs in lieu thereof:

"8. (1) Subject to subsection (2), no person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any waste in or about any landfill site owned by The Corporation of the City of North Bay except waste originating from the City of North Bay or the Township of North Himsforth.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to any person who is authorized under a subsisting agreement with The Corporation of the City of North Bay for the receipt of waste from lands within the Township of Blyth, Lyman, Notma (Tilden Lake), Merrick or Stewart (Little Tomiko Lake)."

9. (1) Schedule A of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by adding the following words to paragraph (2) (h): "from within the City of North Bay or the Township of North Himsworth".

10. (2) Schedule A of By-law 135-92 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph (4):


"4. Where any waste which originates from an authorized area outside the City of North Bay or the Township of North Himsworth is accepted then the minimum load fee shall be \$20.00."


11. This by-law comes into force as of June 27, 1994.
