BY-LAW NO. 118-92

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A
PORTION OF MAIN STREET FROM FRASER STREET
TO FERGUSON STREET.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Main Street from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the portion of Main Street from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, July 31, 1992, for the purpose of the Heritage Festival.
2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
3. That prior to 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 31st day of July, 1992, the Director of Transportation and Works will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Main Street to its condition prior to the above closure.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1992.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 8TH DAY OF JUNE 1992.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 8TH DAY OF JUNE 1992.
