

BY-LAW NUMBER 1015.

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay for charges to be assessed to outside Municipalities for the use of fire fighting equipment and Firemen of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

(1) That any Municipality outside of the limits of the City of North Bay shall be charged for the service of the firemen, fire fighting equipment at the following rates.

(a) The sum of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) Dollars for the first hour and FIFTY (\$50.00) Dollars for every subsequent hour:- time to be taken from the time the equipment and firemen shall leave and return to the fire hall.

(b) Municipalities receiving assistance to provide oil and gasoline during the fire period and for the return of the equipment to the fire hall at North Bay.

(2) Specific arrangements are to be made with the Municipality or Municipalities calling for assistance and the firemen and fire equipment are to attend fires only under specific instructions to the Fire Chief or his representatives by the Mayor of the City of North Bay or the Chairman of the Fire, Water and Light Committee of the said City.

THIS BY-LAW shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
