

BY-LAW NO. 2068

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for closing parts of Hammond Street, Fisher Street, Robert Avenue, Cassells Street, Nelson Street, Brennan Street, Water Street, High Street, Olive Street, Lorne Avenue, Aubrey Street, as well as parts of certain lanes in the vicinity thereof, all within the City of North Bay and shown on Plans M-161, M-163, M-165 and M-189 filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, Ontario.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of North Bay deems it necessary to close the above mentioned portions of streets and lanes and to convey same to Department of Highways, Ontario, in accordance with a certain agreement dated May 1st, 1958 made between the said Department of Highways, Ontario, The Hydro Electric Power Commission, and The Corporation of the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS Notice of the intention of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to close same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the local newspaper.

AND WHEREAS the said Council has undertaken to hear in person or by their counsel, solicitor, or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applies to be heard.

AND WHEREAS no such person has so applied.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That all and singular those certain parts of streets and lanes shown as the portions coloured yellow on plans by Department of Highways, Ontario, numbers P-2785-89 and P-2785-90, filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, Ontario, be and the same are hereby closed and stopped up.
2. That the said parts of streets and lanes, properly described in registerable form, be made the subject of an Application to the Local Master of Titles, that the above mentioned registered plans be amended and revised accordingly.
