

BY-LAW NO. 1362

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1298 which is a By-Law regulating traffic in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend Py-Law 1298.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:

THAT by-law No. 1298 be amended by striking out the words, six and nine o'clock in Paragraph 9, Section 2, Subsection B and substituting therefore five and nine-thirty o'clock so that Paragraph 9, Section 2, Subsection B shall read as follows:

9 (b) No delivery of coal or wood shall be made on that portion of Main Street between Sherbrooke and Foran Streets except between the hours of five and nine-thirty o'clock in the forenoon.

THIS BY-LAW shall take effect immediately after the passing thereof.

READ a first time in Open Council this 2nd. day of March, 1942.

READ a second time in Open Council this 2nd. day of March, 1942.

RULES OF ORDER were suspended and by-law read a third time short and passed this 2nd. day of March, 1942.
