BY-LAW NO. 115-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION FOR IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION OF THE STREET LIGHTING SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, Section 354(1) Paragraph 53 authorizes the Council to pass a By-law for the purposes therein stated;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable and necessary to pass the within by-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT the construction for improvement and extension of the street lighting system as described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law for the sum of \$41,980.00 be hereby authorized.
- THAT the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the North Bay Hydro Electric Commission for the construction of the work.
- THAT the Treasurer of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to borrow from time to time from any bank or person by way of Promissory Note or Notes temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction as aforesaid pending the completion thereof and pending the issue and sale of the debentures hereinafter referred to but in no event shall the aggregate of such borrowings exceed the amount limited in this By-law.
- ANY Promissory Note or Notes issued pursuant to Paragraph 3 hereof shall be sealed with the seal of The Corporation of the City of North Bay and signed by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor and the Treasurer of the City of North Bay.
- THAT debentures to be issued when the work is completed to pay for the cost of such work shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and shall be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan.
- THAT this By-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from The Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64 (1) of The Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 323.
