

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 71-68

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2066 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO PROVIDE THAT THE NORMAL RETIREMENT AGE OF POLICEMEN EMPLOYED BY THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY SHALL BE 60 YEARS.

WHEREAS Section 11 of the regulations made under The Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System Act provides that the normal retirement age of a member is 65 years except in those cases where an employer files a certificate with the Secretary-Treasurer stating that persons who are engaged by the employer as policemen or firemen are entitled to retire at age 60, in which case the normal retirement age of such members is 60 years;

AND WHEREAS the existing Agreement between the Board of Commissioners of Police for the City of North Bay and the North Bay Police Association provides that members of the City Police Force shall retire at age 60;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of North Bay be and he is hereby authorized to file a certificate on behalf of The Corporation of the City of North Bay with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board that employees who are Policemen for the City of North Bay are entitled to retire at age 60.
2. That paragraph 4 of By-law No. 2066 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, including any amendment or amendments thereto, shall be deemed to be and it is hereby amended in accordance with the terms and provisions of this By-law.
3. The provisions of any By-law or By-laws of the former Townships of Widdifield and West Ferris relating to the normal retirement age for Policemen which conflict with the provisions of this By-law shall be deemed to be and they are hereby repealed.
