

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2003-30

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE
RECONVEYANCE OF LANDS DONATED BY
TEMBEC INC. TO THE NORTH BAY-MATTAWA
CONSERVATION AUTHORITY.
(ACCESS TO LAURIER WOODS)

WHEREAS Tembec Inc. has generously donated an acre of land at the end of Brule Street to provide access to the Laurier Woods;

AND WHEREAS the subject lands have been appraised as having a value of FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$45,000.00);

AND WHEREAS Council is authorized to dispose of lands no longer required for municipal purposes;

AND WHEREAS the Council passed Clause No. 1, of General Government Report No. 2001-25 at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, September 26, 2001 to facilitate the transfer of the public access corridor area from Brule Street to the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to transfer Part 1, Plan 36R-11262, to the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority for the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00).
2. The City Treasurer is authorized to provide a Tax Receipt to Tembec Inc. to reflect the appraised value of the donation.
3. That the Mayor and Clerk and the City Solicitor of The Corporation of the City of North Bay are hereby authorized to execute a Transfer/Deed to North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority for the said lands together with such other documents as may reasonably be required to give effect to the transfer.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 24th DAY OF MARCH, 2003.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 24th DAY OF MARCH, 2003.
