

BY-LAW NO. 982

BEING A BY-LAW to fix the Polling Places and appoint Deputy Returning Officers for the holding of Municipal Elections for the year, 1931.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a by-law fixing Polling Places and appointing Deputy Returning Officers for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors, to select a Mayor and Ten (10) Aldermen, Two (2) for each Ward, to transact the Municipal Affairs of the City and for the selection of Public School Trustees

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Polling Place No. 1 for the purpose of said election shall be in Mr. W. Santary's Store, 384 Main Street West, and A.E. Whittingham and T.H. Winters are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

2. THAT Polling Place No. 2 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Court House, Bye and McIntyre Streets and Gordon Darling and C.J. O'Grady are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

3. THAT Polling Place No. 3. for the purpose of said election shall be in Jas. Palangio's Store , 38 Front Street and G. Elmit, G. Morgan and J.J. Leaman are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

4. THAT Polling Place No. 4 for the purpose of said election shall be in Mrs. A. Groulx residence, 104 Cassells Street and W.B. Cavanagh and H.T. Relph are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

5. THAT Polling Place No. 5 for the purpose of said election shall be in the City Hall, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets and J. R. Casey and G.L. Riches are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

6. THAT Polling Place No. 6 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Canadian Legion Club Rooms, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets, and E.B. Willis and J.E. Lehman are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

7. THAT Polling Place No. 7 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Orange Hall, Fisher and McIntyre Streets and G.L. Lindburg and R. Putnam are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

8. THAT Polling Place No. 8 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Orange Hall, Fisher and McIntyre Streets, and L.R. Hume and R.J. Peel are hereby appointed Deputy returning Officers.

9. THAT Polling Place No. 9 for the purpose of said election shall be at A. Orfankos Store, 307 McIntyre Street East and T.E. Burrows and W.H. Reddaway are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

10. THAT Polling Place No. 10. for the purpose of said election shall be at J.H. Tomkins, 18 Laurier Avenue and T.S. Buchanan, W.C. Collyer and Alex Smith are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

11. THAT Polling Place No. 11 for the purpose of said election shall be at the Orange Hall, Cassells street, between Third Avenue and Percy Street, and C. Britton, P.W. White and G.A. Winton are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

12. THAT Polling Place No. 12 for the purpose of said election shall be in E. Drury's House, 111 Front Street and Ed. Everitt and V.B. Wilcock are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

13. THAT Polling Place No. 13 for the purpose of said election shall be in St. Simon's Parish Hall, Cassells and King Street and A.A. Hansman and F.A. York are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

14. THAT the Railway Employee's, Express Messengers and Commercial Travellers Advance Polling Place for the purpose of said Election, shall be in the City Hall, Ferguson and McIntyre Streets, and A.C. Amos is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,

Read a Second Time in Open Council this 3rd day of November 1930
