

BY-LAW NUMBER 495

BEING A BY-LAW FOR REGULATING TRANSIENT TRADERS  
IN THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, that a By-Law should be enacted regulating transient traders within the limits of the Town of North Bay.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ENACTED by the Municipal Corporation of the Town of North Bay, as follows:-

1. There shall be taken out by every transient trader or other person in the Town of North Bay whose name has not been entered on the last revised Assessment roll of the Municipality in respect of income or business assessment for the then current year, and who may offer goods, wares or merchandise of any description for sale by auction conducted by himself or by a licensed auctioneer or otherwise, or who offers them for sale in any other manner, a license authorizing him to carry on his trade or calling within the limits of the said town, and for which license the person obtaining same shall pay at the time of the issue of such license the sum of Fifty Dollars.
2. No transient trader or other person coming within the limits of the provisions of this By-Law, shall commence to trade or transact business within the limits of the said town until the said license above provided for has been paid for and issued to him or them.
3. The Clerk of the Municipality is hereby empowered and required on the application of any person for a license for the purpose mentioned in this By-Law, to issue such license to such person on payment of the license fee hereinbefore provided for.
4. A license issued under the provisions of this By-Law shall not be transferable.

5. This By-Law is issued and governed by the provisions of Revised Statutes of Ontario 1914, chap. 192, Sec. 420, Sub-Sees. 6 and 7.

6. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-Law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of Fifty Dollars for each offence exclusive of costs and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith the said penalty and costs or the costs only may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender. In case of there being no distress found out of which such penalty can be levied the convicting Magistrate may commit the offender to the common jail in the Town of North Bay with or without hard labor for any time not exceeding six calendar months unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.

7. All former By-Laws of the Municipality of the Town of North Bay with reference to transient traders, are hereby repealed.

8. This By-Law shall take effect immediately after the passing thereof.
