BY-LAW NUMBER

BEING a By-law to amend By-law Number 624 of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to amend By-law No. 624.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows:

- 1. Wherever the word "REGULARLY" appears in said By-law number 624 the same shall be struck out.
- That last part of paragraph five (5) of said By-law commencing with the words uprovided also that licensed Hotel Keepers, and so on be struck out.

That paragraph seven (7) of said By-law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefore:
Every license issued under authority of said By-law shall be dated the First day of January of each year and shall expire on the Thirty-first day of December of the year of the issue thereof. The usual fee shall be ober year of the issue thereof. The usual fee shall be charged no matter what part of the year the license is taken out.

In any effect until the proper fee therefor has been paid to the Town Treasurer and his receipt therefor duly endorsed on the license, whereupon it shall be executed by the Town Clerk.

Licensees desiring renewal of their licenses shall make their applications for such renewals on or before the thirty-first day of December as provided for in this By-law, and such applications for renewals shall operate as a protection against the penalties of this By-law, to such applicants as comply with all the terms hereof until license applied for shall issue.

'4'. To Clause fifteen of the By-law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefore:-

For each driver's ligense. .50 'AND' IT IS FURTUER understood that every person obtaining a ligense inder this By-law for a dray, automobile or horse shall first obtain a yearly license of Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) and thereafter shall pay the fee set forth in this clause for each additional dray, automobile or horse by him . automobile used by him.

PROVIDED nevertheless, that every license or transfer of license shall be invalid and of no effect, until the fee payable therefor shall have been paid to the Town Treasurer, and his receipt for same has been endorsed on said license or transfer as per Section (7). A license for a one horse dray or cab may, at any time, on proper application be exchanged for a license for a two horse cab or dray, by paying the difference between the two fees.

5. The following shall be the tariff of fares which may be charged under this By-law for service rendered:-

1. TAXIS AND CABS

- (a) For conveyance of one or two persons (comprising a party) from one point to another, as required by such person or persons, within the Town Limits (except as provided by clause D) one way single, with ordinary hand baggage, seventy-five cents (75¢). Child in arms free. Return with stop of ten minutes, One Dollar (\$1.00)
 - (b) For a party of three or more the fare shall be computed at each additional person one way, twenty-five cents.
- (c) Hired by the hour for conveyance of persons within the Town Limits, from one to four persons first hour, three dollars (\$3.00). Each additional person over party of four, seventy-five cents (75¢). Each additional hour party of four two dollars (\$2.00). Each additional person over party of four, fifty cents (50¢).
 - (d) Special rate between the Ganadian Pacific Railway Station and the National Railway Station, and that part of the Town as far East Sherbrooke street, and as far west as Cassells street, and as far north as 2nd. Avenue, and as far south as Oak street, for the conveyance of one or two persons from one point to another, within the above limits, one way Single, with ordinary hand baggage, fifty cents (50¢).

Child in arms, free, Return with stop of ten minutes, seventy-five cents (75ϕ) .

For a party of three or more, the fare shall be computed at each additional person, one way, twenty-five cents.

The rate of One Dollar single fare may be charged for each sick person from one point to another within the limits of the Town.

2. DRAYS

- (a) For conveyance of baggage or express of ordinary custom -- One piece fifty cents (50ϕ) . Each additional piece twenty-five cents (25ϕ)
- (b) For conveyance of freight, household effects or other, team work first hour, one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50). Each additional hour or fraction thereof seventy-five (75¢)

Time to be computed from time dray or team was hired for, until time dispensed with.

3. AUTO TRUCK OF DRAYS

- (a) Auto trucks or drays hired by the hour, first hour, three dollars (\$3.00). Each additional hour or fraction thereof, one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50).
- (b) For conveyance of ordinary baggage and express one piece, fifty cents (50ϕ) . Each additional piece, twenty-five cents (25ϕ)

From the hours of 11 P.M to 5.30 A.M., an additional charge of one hundred per cent (100%) of the above rates may be collected.
