BEING A BY-LAT of the Corporation of the Nunicipality of the City of North Bay to close certain lanes within the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay has been reguested, and upon consideration, deems it advisable to close certain lanes between certain parcels of lands being the property of the Board of Truatees of the Roman Catholic Separate Schools of the City of Iorth 3ay, and to convey the said lanes upon their being closed up, to the said 3oard of Trustees of the Roman Catholic Separate schools of the city of North Bay and to aocept in exchange therefor from the said 3oard $k=\begin{aligned} & \text { adjacent property to be used as a lane. }\end{aligned}$

THEREFORE, UNDER AID BY VIRTUE of the authority vested in the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay the Municipal Act being R. S. So. 1927 , Chapter 233 , IHE MUNICIPAL COUNOIL OY GHE CORPOPATION OF THE CIMY OF NOKTH BAY ENACTS AS HOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the part of a lane between lots numbers 364 and 451 and lane at the rear $0 \pm$ lots numbers $361,362,363$, 452, 453 and 454 as the said lane and lots are shown on a plan of sub-division entered in the Office of dand Titles at inorth Yay as Plan $\mathrm{M}-28$ which said Lanes are more particularly descrined in Sohedule "A" which is attached to and forms a part of this By-Law, be and the same are herebir closed and stopped up.
2. THAT forthwith upon this By-Lam taking effect the Munioipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall convey to the Board of Trustees of the Roman Catholio Separate Schools of the City of North 3ay the lanes closed and stopped up under the rrovisions of section 1.

THAT the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Jay do accept in exchange for the Lands to be conveyed under the Provisions of Section 2 a strip of land through lots numbers 364 and 451 according to a plan of sub-division entered in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay as Plan M-28 and which said strip of land is more particularly described in Schedule " 3 " which is attached to and forms a part of this By-Law.
4. THAT the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her counsel or agent any person who claims that his or her lands will be prefudcially affected by this $B_{y}-$ Law and who applies to be heard.
5. THAT this By-Lam shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the statute: in this behalf.
