

BY-LAW NUMBER 596.

BEING a By-law to authorize the construction of granolithic sidewalks on certain streets or parts of streets in the Town of North Bay, as specified in Schedule "A" attached hereto, and to authorize the making of an agreement for the temporary advance to meet the cost thereof.

WHEREAS petitions have been presented to the Council of the Town of North Bay in accordance with an Act respecting Local Improvements, for the construction, under the provisions of the said Act, of granolithic sidewalks on the streets or parts of streets in the said Town, as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached, which petitions were signed respectively by at least two-thirds in number of the owners, representing at least one-half of the value of the lots liable to specially assessed as appears by the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality, and the number of such owners and the value of such lots liable to be specially assessed as appears by the last revised Assessment Roll, aforesaid, having been ascertained and finally determined in accordance with and as provided for by the said Act,

AND WHEREAS the said Council has decided to execute the said work under the direction and supervision of its own officers, and it is desirable to authorize the said work and to authorize the Council to provide from the Town funds of the Municipality or to raise by way of loan upon the debentures of the Municipality, Fifth (50%) per cent of the cost of the construction of the said sidewalks, in addition to the part of the costs to be provided by the Municipality and to authorize the making of an agreement for temporary advances for meeting the cost of the said work, and the payment of such cost by the Town Treasurer, on the Certificate of the Town Engineer approved by the Council,

The Corporation of the Town of North Bay, by the Council thereof, by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Council, therefore enacts as follows:-

1. That the said several sidewalks, as set out in Schedule "A", attached hereto, and all work connected therewith, shall be constructed, laid down, and completed under the direction and

supervision and to the full satisfaction of, the Town Engineer, or such other person or persons as he shall appoint to oversee the same.

2. That immediately upon the completion of the said work, the Town Engineer, or other person in charge thereof, shall report in writing under his hand, to the Town Clerk the total cost of the said work, together with the number of lineal feet therein.

3. That the said work shall be constructed as "Local Improvements", under the provisions of an Act Respecting Local Improvements, and the cost thereof shall be paid in the manner provided by such Act.

4. It shall, and may be, lawful for the Mayor and Treasurer to borrow from any person or persons, body or bodies, corporate, who may be willing to advance the same, such sum or sums of money as may be required to pay for such Local Improvements, and any money so borrowed shall be repaid out of the proceeds of the debentures to be issued for, or on account of, the said work when completed.

5. The Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay consists of Ten (10) Members, and Eight (8) Members of the said Council voted in favour of this By-law, and no member against same.
