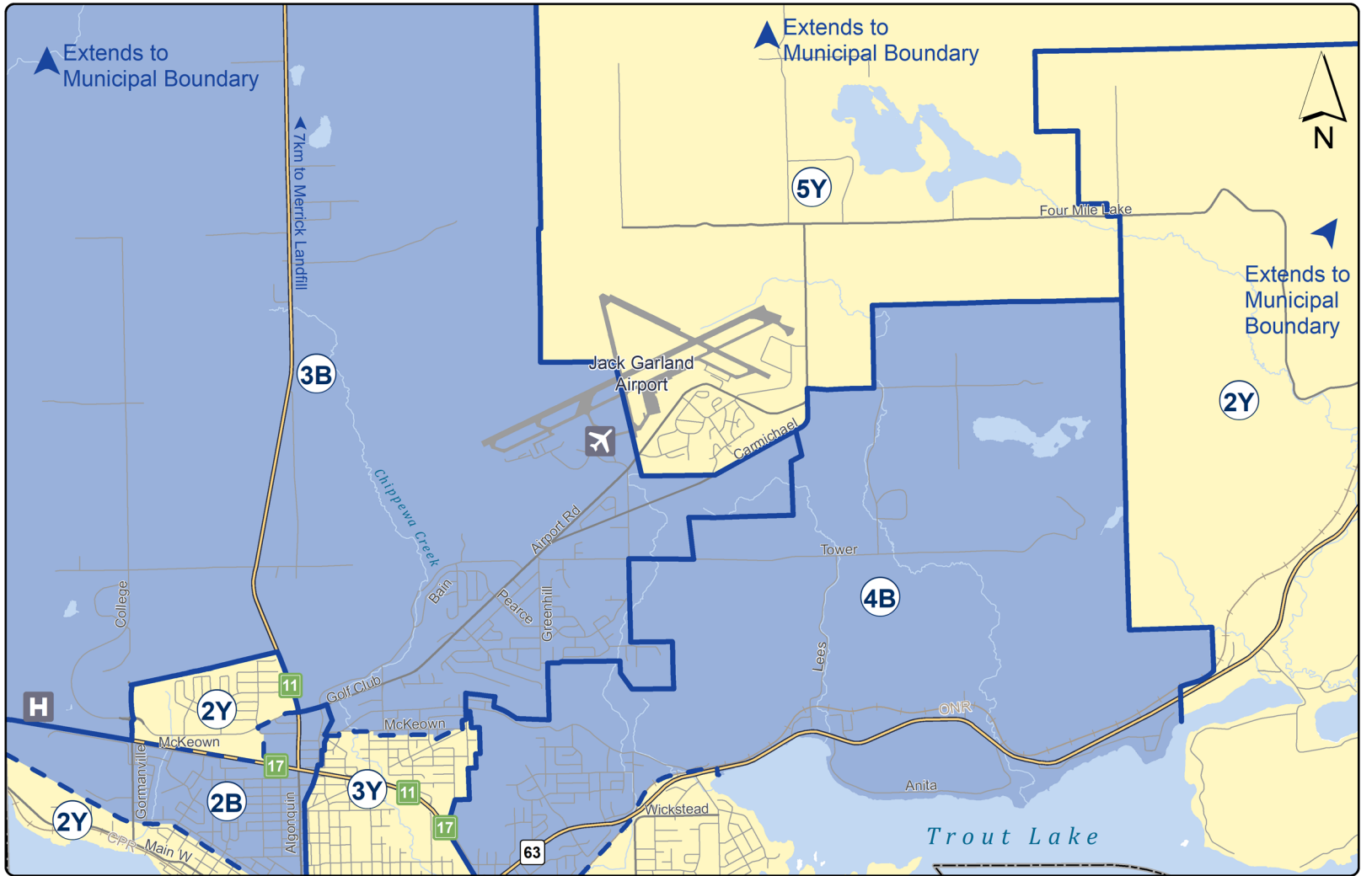

Blue zone - Lakeshore Dr. and West from Oscar St. and Joseph St. North to Regina St.

Yellow Zone - South of Joseph St. and East of Lakeshore Dr. To Bunting Dr. and Mariah St.

2 TUESDAY

Blue zone - Jane St. and North to HWY 17

Yellow Zone - Area 1 - South of Jane St. Gormanville Rd. to Western city limit. **Area 2** - Thibeault Terrace **Area 3** - Peninsula Area, North Shore Area, Stanley's Rd. to Eastern city limit

3 WEDNESDAY

Blue zone - Wallace Heights Area, Cedar Heights Area, Mckeown Ave. from Stockdale Rd to Chapais St. to Northern city limits

Yellow Zone - South of McKeown Ave. from Stockdale Rd. to Chapais St. and North of Cassells St. and Front St.

4 THURSDAY

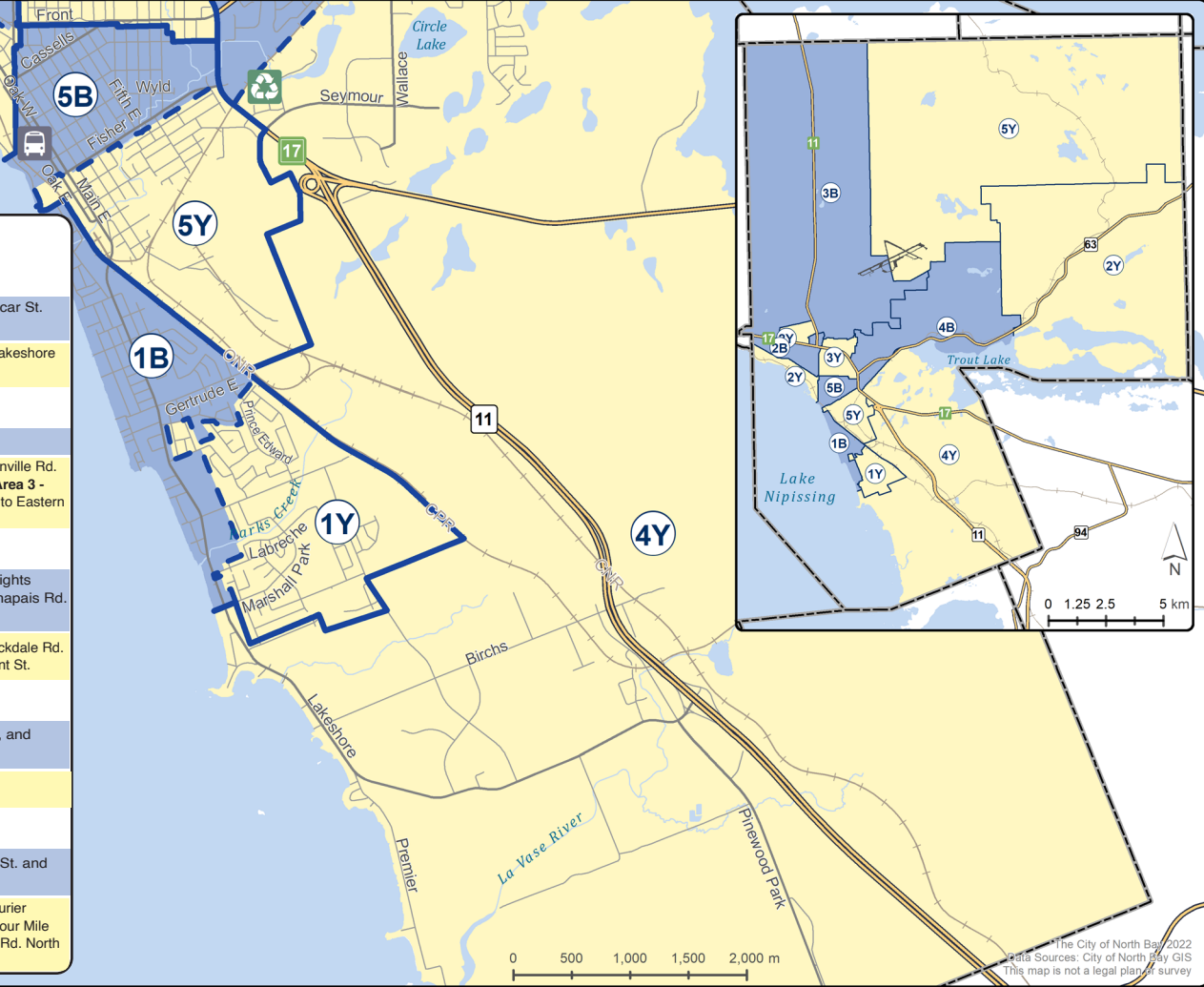
Blue zone - North of HWY 11/17, Graniteville, and Trout Mills North to Hillside Lake.

Yellow Zone - Birchaven and Rural East Area to Southern city limit.

5 FRIDAY

Blue zone - Fisher St. and North to Cassells St. and Front St.

Yellow Zone - Area 1 - South of Fisher St. to Laurier Woods **Area 2** - CFB and North to City Limits, Four Mile Lake Rd. West of Stanleys Rd. & Widdifield Stn. Rd. North to City Limits

Note: The landfill is closed on Sundays during the late fall and winter from Thanksgiving Day to Victoria Day.

Please arrive with enough time to unload before closing.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION PRACTICES



Place garbage and recyclables at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day, or no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the night before.



Maximum of two garbage bags or containers per week. Max weight of 15kg each. Containers no larger than 150L (33 Gal). Additional bags require bag tags.



Unlimited amount of standard Blue Boxes with a lip on the side are accepted every 2 weeks. Bags and large non-standard Blue Box containers will not be picked-up.



Items not picked up at the curb: household hazardous waste, car parts, tires, liquid waste, electronics, furniture, biomedical waste, mattresses, and grass clippings.

- Batteries
- Cleaning products
- Cosmetics
- Fertilizers
- Fluorescent light bulbs and tubes
- Gasoline
- Glues and adhesives
- Nail polish and polish remover
- Fire extinguishers
- Paint thinner and varnish remover
- Perfume and cologne
- Pesticides, insecticides and herbicides
- Propane cylinders/tanks
- Pool chemicals
- Used motor oil and filters
- Cooking oil

Residents can drop off 60L of household hazardous waste per household per week.

Not accepted: unidentified items, and those with refrigerants, (AC units, fridges, freezers, water coolers, and dehumidifiers) PCBs, explosives, biological/pathological waste, and radioactive waste.

BLUE BOX TIPS FOR WINDY DAYS

Windy weather on recycling days can result in blue box material blowing into the streets and neighbour's yards. To help prevent blue box litter, here are some helpful tips to keep your recyclables in your blue box:

1. When windy days are forecasted, try to place blue box containers out on the morning of collection, before 7 a.m., instead of the night before. This ensures your recyclables are not in the elements for an extended period.
2. Items such as cans, bottles, and containers that can be crushed, should be crushed. Condensing your recyclables makes them more dense and less likely to blow away.
3. Stack your heavier recyclables on top of lighter materials inside your recycling boxes.

Additional helpful tip – remember to write your address on your blue box and garbage cans to help retrieve it on windy days.

WINTER COLLECTION TIPS

- Don't place containers or bags on the road blocking traffic or on the sidewalk blocking pedestrians.
- Don't place containers or bags on top of or behind a pile of snow.
- Place containers and bags on a cleared driveway or area with one meter all around.

THE 6 R'S OF WASTE REDUCTION



Rethink - Is the product needed? Think of other options that produce less



Refuse - Think before you buy, shop less, and purchase items with less packaging.



Reduce - Borrow items and limit items sent to the landfill. Use alternatives.



Reuse - Up-cycle instead of throwing away. Bring your own bags and bottles.



Repair - Fix items before disposing or purchasing new.



Recycle - Clean and sort items in the appropriate stream.

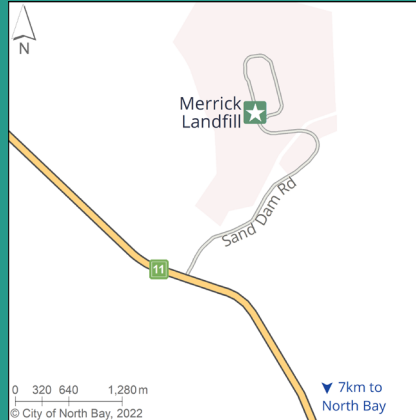

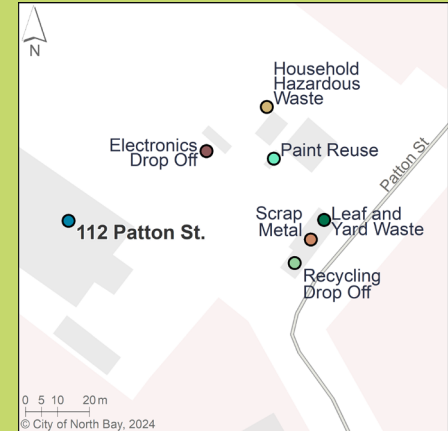
