Being a By-law authorizing The Corporation of the City of North Bay to execute a Bond of Indemnity in favour of The Equitable Life Insurance Company of Canada, Waterloo, Ontario, in the matter of the Estate of Joseph Villeneuve;

WHEREAS it is desirable for The Corporation of the City of North Bay to execute a Bond of Indemnity in favour of The Equitable Life Insurance Company of Canada in order to obtain payment of the proceeds of Policy No. 2850 issued by the said Company in the principal sum of \$1,000.00 plus accrued interest to be applied on a prorata basis in partial payment of funeral expenses owing to McGuinty Funeral Home and amounting to \$495.00 and hospitalization charges owing to The Corporation of the City of North Bay amounting to \$1,545.84;


