THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 89-70

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 9-69 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is considered advisable to amend By-law No. 9-69 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 3.1 of By-law No. 9-69 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay is deleted therefrom, and replaced by the following:
 - "3.1 No building, structure or land shall be used, and no building or structure shall hereafter be erected or altered within the territorial limits of the City of North Bay, as constituted prior to January 1st, 1968, except in conformity with the provisions of this by-law."
- Section 4.44.3 of said By-law is amended by deleting the following therefrom:

"4.44.3 Automobile Parking Space

Minimum area - One Hundred and eighty square feet (180 sq.ft.)

Minimum Length - Twenty feet (20 ft.)

Minimum Width - Nine feet (9 ft.)"

and replacing it with the following:

"4.44.3 Automobile Parking Space

Minimum Area - Two Hundred square feet (200 sq. ft.)

Minimum Length - Twenty feet (20 ft.)

Minimum Width - Ten feet (10 ft.)"

- 3. Section 5.7 of said By-law is deleted therefrom and replaced by the following:
 - "5.7 Permitted encroachments in yards:

that any by-law authorizing the said undertaking is passed by a three-fourths vote of all members of the council of the said corporation, and




