

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAYBY-LAW NO. 33-72

BEING A BY-LAW APPOINTING THE PERSONS  
HEREINAFTER LISTED TO THE RESPECTIVE  
OFFICES OR POSITIONS HEREINAFTER SET  
FORTH FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE CORPOR-  
ATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF  
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That for the purposes of The Corporation of the City of  
North Bay, the following persons be appointed to the respective  
offices or positions hereinafter set forth:

2. That the aforesaid appointments shall be in accordance  
with and subject to such Terms of Reference which have hereto-  
fore been established or which may hereafter be established  
relating to the respective offices or positions aforesaid.

3. The salaries payable for the aforesaid respective offices  
or positions including fringe benefits shall be in accordance  
with the salary schedule or schedules including fringe benefits  
from time to time in effect.

4. This By-law shall come into full force and effect as of  
and from the first day of April 1972 and shall remain in full  
force and effect until amended or repealed.

5. All previous By-laws or sections thereof inconsistent with  
the terms and provisions of this By-law shall be deemed to be  
and they are hereby repealed.
