NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

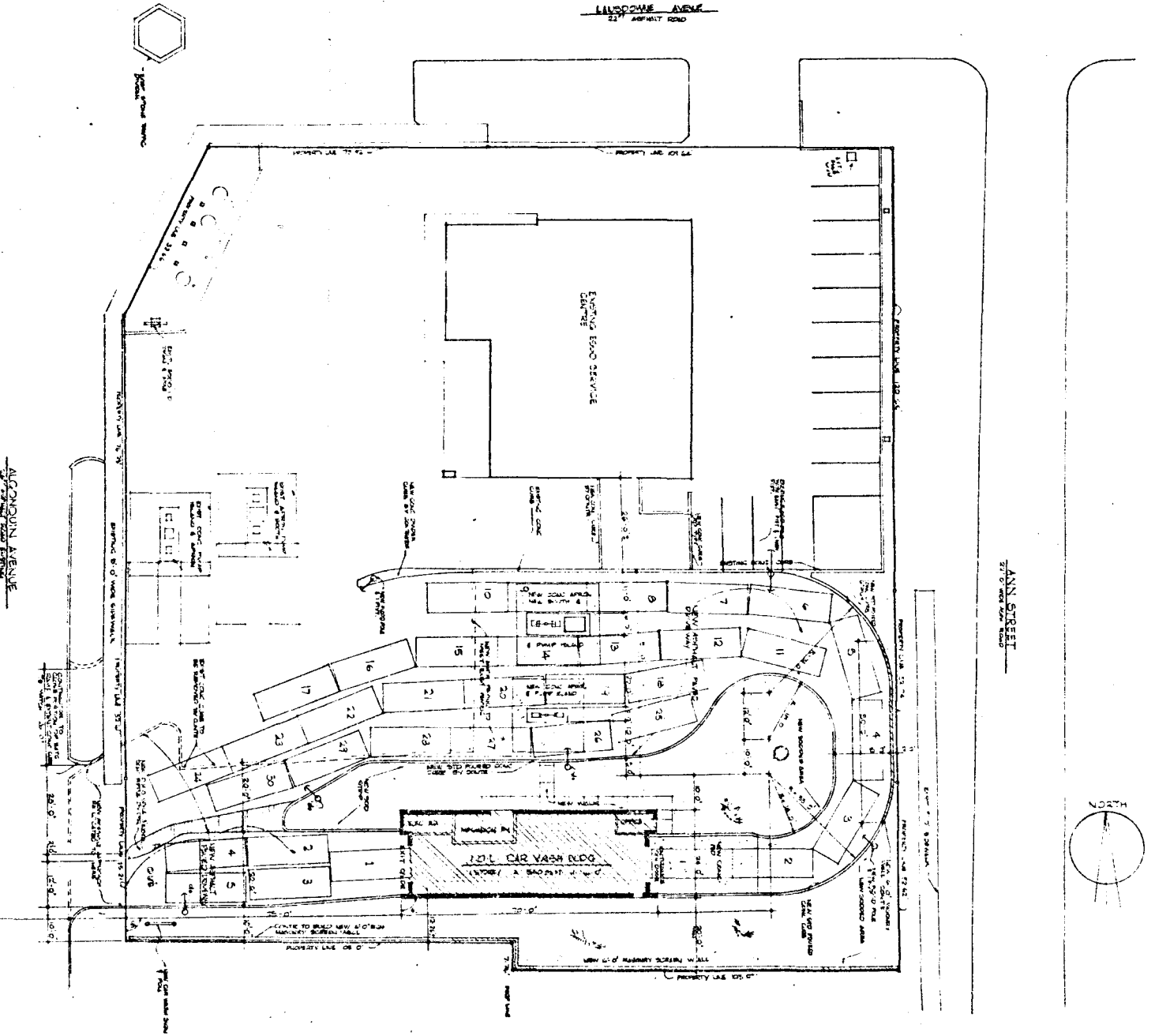
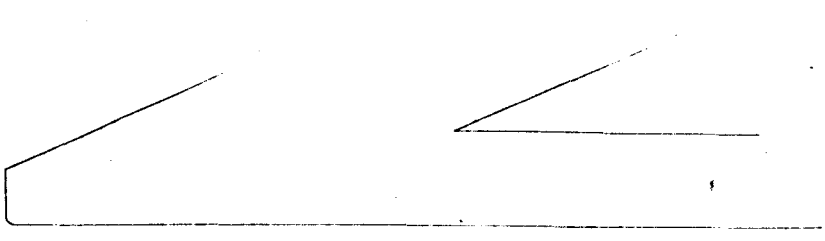
1. Schedule "B" of By-law No. 20-71 is amended
