

BY-LAW NO. 1867

BEING A BY-LAW to provide that the term of office of all members of the Council of the City of North Bay shall be two years and for the holding of Biennial Elections.

WHEREAS the Council of a local municipality may, under the provisions of the Municipal Act, by By-law, provide that the term of office of members of the Council of the municipality shall be two years and that such by-law may provide for biennial elections.

AND WHEREAS it has been deemed expedient that the term of office of members of the Council of the City of North Bay shall be two years and Biennial Elections be held.


THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That after the final passing of this by-law, the term of office of members of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall be two years,
2. That, after the final passing of this by-law, biennial elections be held and, accordingly, an election shall be held every two years for the election of all the members of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
3. That all the members of Council, elected at the election next after the passing of this by-law and thereafter shall hold office for a two-year term.
4. That any provision or provisions in any by-law or by-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
5. This by-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof.
