BY-LAW NO. 2427

Being a By-law authorizing the execution of that certain Lease Agreement dated the First day of March 1967 between The Corporation of the City of North Bay, therein called the "City" of the First Part, and The North Bay and District Y.M.C.A., therein called the "Y.M.C.A." of the Second Part.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay do enter into that certain Lease Agreement dated the first day of March 1967 between The Corporation of the City of North Bay, therein called the "City" of the First Part, and The North Bay and District Y.M.C.A., therein called the "Y.M.C.A." of the Second Part, upon and subject to the terms and conditions therein set forth.

2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute the aforesaid Lease Agreement on behalf of The Corporation of the City of North Bay and to affix thereto the Corporate Seal.

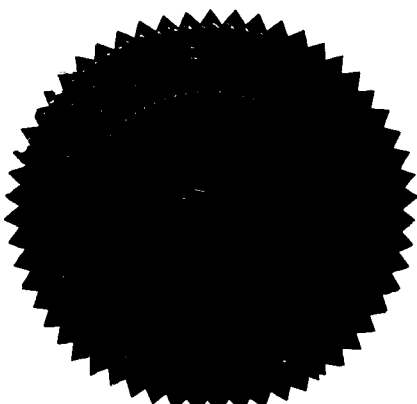

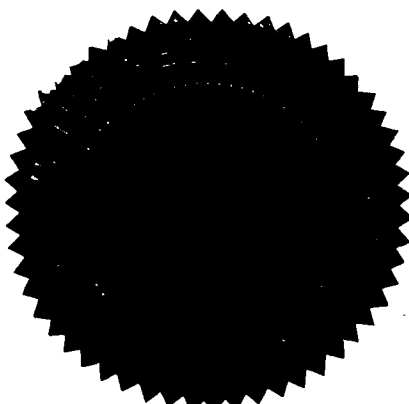

UPON THE APPLICATION OF The Corporation of the City of  
North Bay for approval of the construction of the storm sewers  
described in Schedule "A" attached hereto at an estimated cost  
of \$80,850.12 and of the borrowing of the sum of \$70,850.12  
therefor, and upon reading the material filed;

THE BOARD ORDERS, under and in pursuance of the legisla-  
tion hereinbefore referred to, and of any and all other powers  
vested in the Board, that the said application be and the same  
is hereby granted, and that the Corporation may now proceed  
with the said undertaking and for such purpose may pass a by-  
law authorizing the said undertaking and all other requisite  
by-laws, including by-laws providing for the issue of debentures  
in a principal amount not exceeding \$70,850.12, repayable over  
a term of not more than fifteen years, and may borrow money  
to the extent sufficient to provide an amount not exceeding  
\$70,850.12 therefor, provided:

1. that any by-law authorizing the said undertaking is  
passed by a three-fourths vote of all members of the



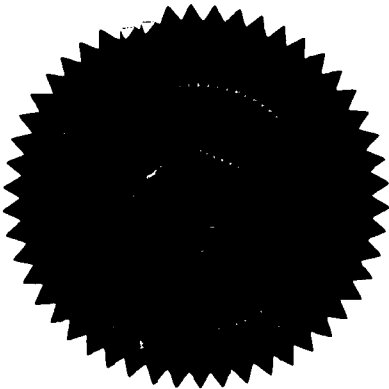

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- council of the said Corporation,
2. that the said Corporation may borrow the whole or any part of the said sum of \$80,850.12 as required pending receipt of subsidies and the sale of debentures, or of moneys to be received from any other source,
  3. that the amount to be debentured shall not exceed in any event the net cost to the Corporation after deducting any grant or contribution from the Province of Ontario or from any other source in respect of the said work, and
  4. that the Corporation in exercising any of its powers approved by this order shall comply with all statutory and other legal requirements related thereto.
