

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 126-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION  
OF A FIRE HALL INCLUDING FURNISHINGS AND  
EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 354 (1), Paragraph 25 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to construct a Fire Hall including furnishings and equipment at an estimated cost of Three Hundred and Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000.)

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That there shall be constructed on land owned by the Corporation on Marshall Avenue and Chippewa Street a Fire Hall including furnishings and equipment at an estimated cost of Three Hundred and Seventy-Five Dollars (\$375,000.)
2. The work shall be executed under the superintendence and direction of the Corporation's architect.
3. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to cause a contract or contracts for the construction of the work to be entered into with some person, firm, or corporation subject to the approval of Council to be declared by resolution.
4. The total estimated cost of the work is Three Hundred and Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000.) and is to be debentured over a period of twenty (20) years. The construction of the Fire Hall including furnishings and equipment shall be as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
5. That the Treasurer of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to borrow from time to time from any bank or person by way of promissory note or notes temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction aforesaid pending the issue and sale of the debentures hereinbefore referred to but in no event shall the aggregate of such borrowings exceed the amount limited in this by-law.
6. Any promissory note or notes issued pursuant to Paragraph 5 hereof shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation of the City of North Bay and signed by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor and the Treasurer of the City of North Bay.
7. That this by-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64 (1) of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 323.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 27TH DAY OF JULY 1981.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS
