

BY-LAW NO. 2064.

BEING A BY-LAW to regulate the closing hours of Retail Drug Stores situate within the limits of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS by petition dated September 26th 1962, it appears that a majority of the occupiers of Retail Drug Stores in the City of North Bay have requested that a by-law be passed regulating the closing of the said Retail Drug Stores during certain hours;

AND WHEREAS this Council deems it expedient to pass a by-law accordingly, under the provisions of section 379a of The Municipal Act as enacted by 1961-62 Ontario Statutes, chapter 86, section 43;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That all Retail Drug Stores in the City of North Bay shall be closed and remain closed on each and every day of every week during the hours between nine o'clock in the afternoon of every day and five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day.
2. That every occupier and agent and servant of such occupier who contravenes the provisions of this by-law shall, upon conviction, forfeit and pay a penalty of One hundred dollars for the first offence, and Three hundred dollars for each subsequent offence, together with any costs which may be imposed by the Convicting Magistrate.
3. This by-law shall take effect on the 10th day of November A. D. 1962.
4. By-law No. 1590 and all other by-laws or parts of by-laws inconsistent with the provisions of the within by-law, are hereby repealed.
