

BY-LAW NUMBER 901.

BEING A BY-LAW authorizing the construction of Sanitary Sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay as a Local Improvement under the Provisions of the Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS William Lynch, J. Boucher, J. Desilets, Alphonse Champagne and others have petitioned the Municipal Council to construct as Local Improvements the work hereinafter described and the Clerk has certified that the Petitions are sufficient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the Petitions in the manner hereinafter described.


THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Sanitary Sewers be constructed on certain streets in the City of North Bay as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached and which forms part of this By-law as a Local Improvement together with all necessary private drains connections and alterations or renewals of same to the lines of the streets.
2. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
3. THE work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such engineer.
4. THAT the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract or contracts for the execution of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
5. THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
6. The Special Assessment shall be paid by 20 equal annual instalments.
7. The debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at the rate of (5%) five per cent per annum and be payable within 20 years on the instalment plan.
8. Any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk.



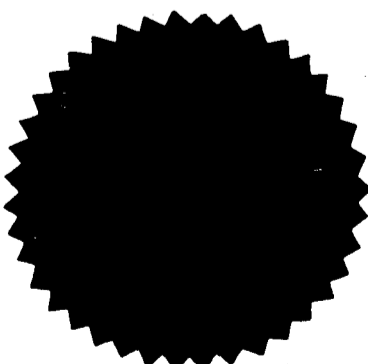

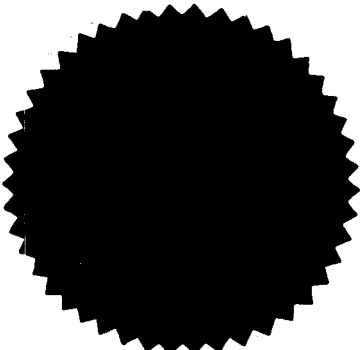
