

### Lakeshore Drive and Marshall Park Drive Intersection Rehabilitation

**North Bay, ON – August 21, 2025** – Rehabilitation to the intersection of Lakeshore Drive and Marshall Park Drive are set to begin in mid-September and will be completed by mid-November 2025. The scope of work includes the removal of the existing traffic control equipment and above grade infrastructure and installation of new traffic and pedestrian control signals, curb & gutter, concrete sidewalks, tactile crossing plates, asphalt boulevard and resurfaced asphalt intersection.

One lane of traffic in all directions will be maintained throughout the project to provide access to local properties and ensure safe travel through the construction zone. Short traffic delays may be required at times to complete underground infrastructure work, including electrical duct installation, asphalt pulverizing, installation of curb and gutter and surface paving.

Further notices with additional project information will be provided by the contractor, Pioneer Construction Inc., ahead of construction.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT ONCE CONSTRUCTION BEGINS:

<b>Work Hours</b>	Work on this project will occur Monday to Friday from 7:00am until 7:00pm. During various operations the contractor will be permitted to work on Saturdays with proper notice. Working on Sundays is not permitted without special permission.
<b>Traffic Management</b>	Traffic may be reduced to one lane using flaggers and/or temporary traffic control lights during construction.
<b>Cars and Pedestrians</b>	Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure safe travel of all users including pedestrians and bicycle riders. Every effort will be made to manage traffic and closures for the safety of construction workers, pedestrians and residents. Road users should expect delays travelling through this section for the duration of the project.
<b>Parking</b>	Parking will not be permitted anywhere on these road locations during active construction work. When needed, temporary parking arrangements will be provided by the contractor to those residents who cannot enter their driveway due to location of underground and above ground infrastructure construction.
<b>Pedestrians</b>	Pedestrians are encouraged to travel on designated areas provided by the contractor.

<b>Deliveries</b>	Deliveries may occur during construction using local access but may not always be possible due to the location of installing infrastructure. The Contractor will make every effort to assist with delivery of your packages.
<b>Residents</b>	Residents along each road section indicated will have access to their property at all times except when various restrictions occur (construction of various infrastructures in the area of their property driveway – i.e. paving and sidewalk pouring). The Contractor will assist with picking up your garbage and recyclables placed in front of the residence and delivering to the collection agency on the day of normal schedule pick-up.
<b>Businesses</b>	All businesses' access will remain open during the construction and where necessary, signage may be placed at both the ends of the construction limits indicating where to access the business. The Contractor will assist with picking up your garbage and recyclables placed in front of the business and delivering to the collection agency on the day of normal schedule pick-up.
