THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 118-73

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CIVIC ADMINISTRATION BUILDING INCLUDING A CIVIC SQUARE AND UNDERGROUND PARKING FACILITIES.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to construct a civic administration building including a civic square and underground parking facilities at an estimated cost of Two Million Five Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,522,000.) of which the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$1,532,000.) is to be debentured.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT there shall be constructed on land owned by The Corporation in the blocks bounded by McIntyre, Worthington Wyld and Sherbrooke Streets a civic administration building including a civic square and underground parking facilities at an estimated cost of Two Million Five Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,522,000)
- 2. THE work shall be executed under the superintendence and direction of the Corporation's architect.
- 3. THE Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to cause a contract or contracts for the construction of the work to be entered into with some person, firm or corporation subject to the approval of council to be declared by resolution.
- THE total estimated cost of the work is Two Million Five Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,522,000.) of which amount the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$1,532,000.) is to be debentured over a period of twenty (20) years. The difference between the total cost and the amount to be debentured, that is, Nine Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$990,000.) will be provided for by a reserve fund of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.), the anticipated sale of city owned property in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (250,000.) and an allotment from current revenue of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.) in each of the years 1974, 1975 and 1976.
- 5. THAT the Treasurer of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to borrow from time to time from any bank or person by way of promissory note or notes temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction aforesaid pending the issue and sale of the debentures hereinbefore referred to but in no event shall the aggregate of such borrowings exceed the amount limited in this by-law.


