

Notice Of Public Meeting
In The Matter Of Proposed Amendments To The
Official Plan and Zoning By-law 2015-30 to Trout Lake Influence Area

Take Notice That the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay will hold the statutory Public Meeting on **Monday, October 27th, 2025 at 5:30 p.m.** at the City Hall, Council Chambers, 200 McIntyre Street East, North Bay, to consider a proposed amendment to the City of North Bay's Official Plan and Zoning By-Law No. 2015-30 under Section 17 and Section 34 of The Planning Act, Chap. P.13, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

The proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment would implement policies and regulations regarding the development and re-development within the Trout Lake Influence Area and major inflowing streams.

Purpose and Effect of the proposed amendments is to amend the current policies with regards to Trout Lake and major inflowing streams into Trout Lake to direct future and redevelopment of new and existing properties to protect and improve water quality and implement best management practices on the properties within the Trout Lake Influence Area and to permit Limited Lot creation within the Trout Lake Influence Area.

The proposed amendments are based on the Trout Lake Management Study.

A key map is not provided as the proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment are not site specific applies to the entire Trout Lake Influence Area.

Any Person may attend the Public Meeting and/or make written or oral representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of North Bay on the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendment, you must make a written request to the City Clerk, Karen McIsaac (200 McIntyre Street East, North Bay ON P1B 8V6) karen.mcisaac@northbay.ca.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of City Council of the City of North Bay to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of North Bay before the proposed Official Plan Amendment and/or Zoning By-law Amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of North Bay before the Official Plan and/or Zoning By-law Amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
