BY-LAW NUMBER 928.

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law #779 regulating Traffic in the Public Streets in the City of North Bay, in certain particulars.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend Traffic By-law #779 of the City of North Bay, in certain particulars.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT Section #23 of said By-Law #779 be amended by striking out all the words in the last line after the word "Street" and inserting in lieu thereof a Comma (,) and the works "Golf Street and Memorial Drive shall be designated as through Streets".
- 2. THAT said By-law #779 be further amended by adding thereto the following as Section 35 and Section 36. Section 35:-
- (1) No person shall park any wehicle for the purpose of sale, repairs or washing on any street within the City of North Bay.
- (2) Washing of vehicles upon any City Street is strictly prohibited.
- (3) No car shall be parked on either side of McIntyre Street between Ferguson Street and One Hundred and Thirty-two (132) Feet Westerly.

Section 36:-

No horse or horses shall be left unattended unless securely tethered by means of weights or otherwise and in such a manner as will not impede traffic of any nature.

3. THIS By-law shall come into effect as soon as approved by the Dapartment of Public Highways of Ontario.
