

BY-LAW NUMBER 738A.

*Approved

BEING a By-law to provide for holding the Annual election of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay on the first Monday of December in each year, instead of holding the Election as heretofore.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to change the date of the annual Municipal Election to the first Monday of December of each year.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :-

(1) THAT the Municipal Election for Corporation of the Town of North Bay shall hereafter be held on the first Monday of December of each and every year hereafter.

(2) THAT the consent of the electors of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay to the passing of this By-law be submitted at the Annual Municipal Elections to be held on the first Monday in January, 1925, and that the final reading of this By-law be deferred until the consent of the said electors has been so determined.
